

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, it is the recommendation of the Natural Resources Committee to support Lower Similkameen Indian Band's resolution BRC #10, which; opposes dam modification and electrical production, any means of artificial salmon passage, strongly supports removal of Enloe Dam, remediation of contaminated sediment behind the dam, and restoration of the Similkameen River to its historic and natural condition.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that we, the Colville Business Council, meeting in a **SPECIAL SESSION** this **15th day of June, 2017** acting for and in behalf of the Colville Confederated Tribes, Nespelem Washington, do hereby approve the above recommendation of the Natural Resources Committee.

The foregoing was duly enacted by the Colville Business Council by a vote of **13 FOR 0 AGAINST 0 ABSTAINED**, under authority contained in Article V, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the Confederated Tribes of the Colville Reservation, ratified by the Colville Indians February 26, 1938, and approved by the Commissioner of Indian Affairs on April 19, 1938.
